# GENERAL INFORMATION

## REGISTRATION

Registration opens on Wednesday, March 27<sup>th</sup> at 9:00am. Closing time for registration: Friday, April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at 11:59pm. Online registration will be available on [www.skatescbc.ca](http://www.skatescbc.ca).

## ENTRY FEES

- \$50.00 per skater for first category
- \$25.00 per skater for any additional category

Please note that the committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries in each category; categories will be filled on a first-come, first-serve basis. Based on the numbers of registrations for any given category, the committee reserves the right to cancel that category. Specifically, any category with only one entry will be cancelled. If there is extra time, an exhibition may be offered.

## REFUNDS AND WITHDRAWALS

Full refunds will be given for any cancelled category, or if the entry is withdrawn prior to the closing date. After the closing date, refunds will only be given for medical reasons if the Club office is contacted prior to 9am on May 3<sup>rd</sup>, and the registrar receives a medical certificate.

## MUSIC REGISTRATION

For the 2024 SCBC Star 1-4 Club Competition, competitors must submit their music online through Google Forms. Link will be available following registration closing.

Music registration **must** be uploaded through Google Forms by **11:59 PM EST on April 26<sup>th</sup>**. **Note: You will need a Gmail account to compete the music registration form.**

MP3 file(s) **MUST** be named using the format below:

FIRST NAME LAST NAME\_CLUB NAME\_CATEGORY\_PROGRAM TYPE.mp3

*EXAMPLE: John Smith\_ABC SC\_STAR 5 O13\_Men.mp3*

## ON SITE CHECK IN

On competition day, all competitors must register no later than one hour prior to the scheduled start of their category.

## **MARKING SYSTEM**

The Skate to Standard marking system will be used at this event.

## **AWARDS**

Medals will be presented to skaters finishing first, second, and third in each of the following categories:

- STAR 4 freeskate
- STAR 4 individual elements

Ribbons will be presented to all participants in the following categories:

- STAR 1 – 3 freeskate
- STAR 1 – 3 elements
- STAR 2/3 solo dance
- STAR 2/3 couples dance
- Showcase 1 – 2
- Creative Improv 1 – 2

Awards will be presented periodically throughout the day. Times will be posted in the lobby.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

Competitors must be home club members of Skate Canada Brampton-Chinguacousy.

## **ASSESSMENT QUALIFICATIONS**

As of January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024.

# CATEGORIES

## STARSKATE CATEGORIES

All Freeskate categories from Star 1 – 4 will be judged using the 2023-2024 Skate Canada – Well Balanced Program (WBP) technical package posted at:

## FREESKATE CATEGORIES

Skaters are only permitted to enter one freeskate category.

- **STAR 1 Elements Assessment** – Assess to Standard
- **STAR 2 Freeskate** – Assess to Standard
- **STAR 3 Freeskate** – Assess to Standard
- **STAR 4 Freeskate** - Assess to Standard & Ranked

## INDIVIDUAL ELEMENTS

Elements Categories are an opportunity for skaters to perform free skate elements in a competition format without the constraints of a performance or musical interpretation associated with the use of music. Skaters are able to focus on proper technique and quality while challenging themselves to attempt more difficult elements.

- **STAR 2 Elements** – Assess to standard
- **STAR 3 Elements** – Assess to standard
- **STAR 4 Elements** – Assess to standard with ranking

Procedures for individual elements categories:

- Each skater will perform four elements in isolation in the order listed for their level of competition
- Each element may only be attempted once
- All skaters will perform Element #1 before performing Element #2 and so on, until all four elements have been executed by all skaters
- Spins will not be assigned levels and will be assessed on quality only
- STAR 2 to STAR 4 events will use half-ice to perform the elements

## DANCE CATEGORIES

Please check with your Coach to see what level your skater is at. Limit to one pattern dance per skater. Skate Canada series 8 music will be used, unless otherwise specified.

### **STAR 2/3 Couples Dance – Assess to Standard**

- Each skater must have passed the STAR 1 Dance Assessment
- Pattern Dances to be skated:
  - Pattern Dance #1: Dutch Waltz (2 sequences)
  - Pattern Dance #2: Baby Blues (2 sequences)
- Dance teams must be composed of two skaters
- Key Points will not be used

### **STAR 2/3 Solo Dance – Dutch Waltz – Assess to Standard**

- Skaters will have passed the STAR 1 Dance Assessment
- Pattern Dance to be skated: Dutch Waltz (2 Sequences)

### **STAR 2/3 Solo Dance – Canasta Tango – Assess to Standard**

- Skaters will have passed the STAR 1 Dance Assessment
- Pattern Dance to be skated: Canasta Tango (2 Sequences)

## SHOWCASE

Please check with your coach to see what level your skater is at. Limit to one showcase per skater.

- **Showcase 1**
- **Showcase 2**

## CREATIVE IMPROV

Creative Improv programs are designed only by the skater with minimal preparation. Creative Improv tests the skater's ability to quickly interpret a given piece of music and entertain the audience. There is no coaching permitted for these events.

- All the skaters in each Event are presented with a pre-selected piece of music by the Technical Representative prior to the warm-up
- The music is selected by the Technical Representative or his/her designate
- All skaters in the Event will perform to the same musical selection
- Skaters will listen to the music twice off-ice in a designated area (e.g. dressing room) and once on-ice during the warm-up period
- Skaters are then kept in a sound-proof dressing room until it is their turn to perform
- Simple skating attire is required
- All single jumps are permitted; jumps of any higher rotation will be subject to an illegal element violation if included

Categories offered:

- **Creative Improv 1** – Assess to standard (must have passed a Star 1 assessment)
- **Creative Improv 2** – Assess to standard (must have passed a Star 4 assessment but no higher than Star 6 freeskate)
